61. Gatwick Noise Consultation

Although much of this document was very technical, the Chairman considered that air control did not enforce the continuous descent path on in-coming flights. This subjected residents to unnecessary and unacceptable levels of noise, particularly in the summer mornings and at weekends. It was agreed that levels of noise from aircraft were increasing and to respond to the consultation accordingly.

62. Any other Business

The Chairman reported that Edward King, the District Councillor, had proposed altering the built-up boundary to include the Mill Hall buildings. It was considered that any such change could be controversial but planning officers had confirmed that any proposals for alterations would be subject to full consultation.
