To consider current infrastructure requirements in the parish:

- a. To review progress of infrastructure provision in the parish against the Cuckfield Neighbourhood Plan Infrastructure Assessment produced in 2014 (attached)
 - b. To add new infrastructure requirements to the existing short list, where a recent or proposed development is expected to generate additional demand on local need
 - c. To identify which items on the updated short list will fulfil requirements for allocation against the current S106 fund availability, held by MSDC (particularly in the Local Community Infrastructure and Public Art categories ref spreadsheet attached)
 - d. To resolve to collaborate with MSDC to progress these infrastructure projects; a list to be forwarded to MSDC by 1st September
