To consider the current condition of the ladies and gents toilets at the Queen's Hall and whether to investigate their renovation

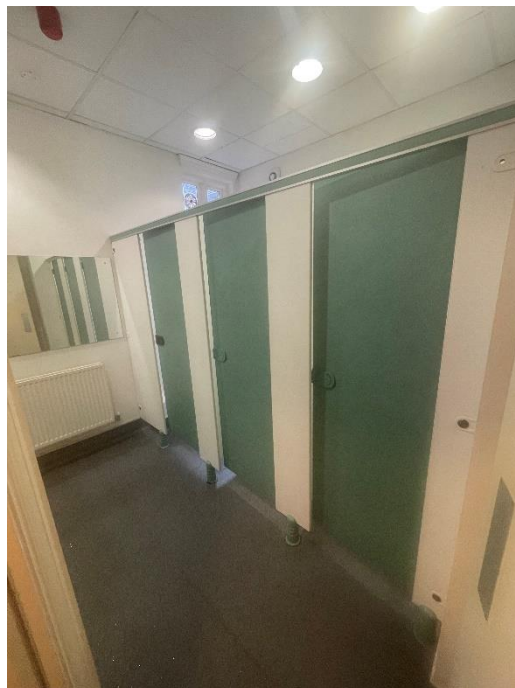
1. Overview

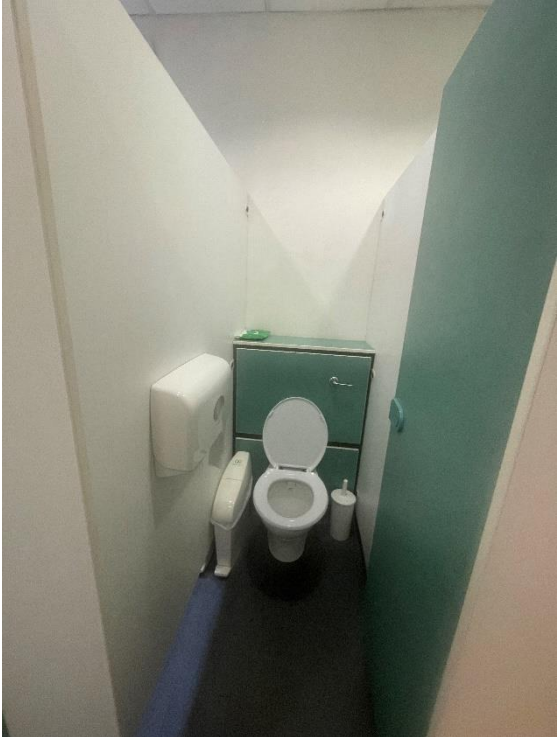

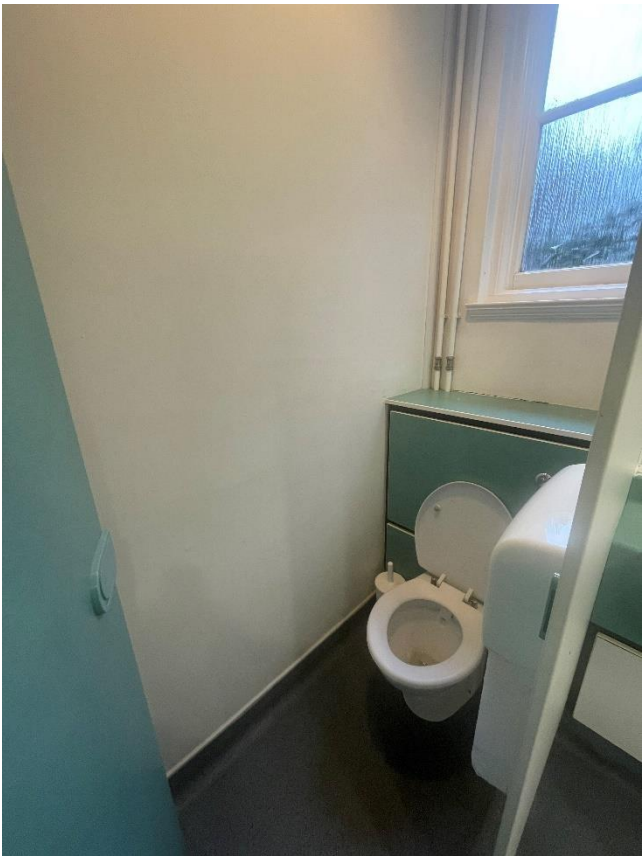






Gents Toilets
