Since writing my initial email it has been suggested to reform the vestry steps to the same height of the newly laid path, thus eliminating the potential trip hazard. Is there a planning regulation that dictates the depth and tread of each step and would we be able to use the same brick paviours as used on the path?

In respect of amending lights, it was just a case of replacing the bulb with a brighter bulb in the existing lamp attached to the north east side of the church and placing in the ground next to the top of the steps two battery-operated sensor lamps.

Dear Emily,

Cuckfield Parish Council's contractor has now completed the refurbishment of the churchyard paths in brick.

Church representatives approved the completed work including the area between the north path and vestry steps (as per images attached) during meetings on 15 and 16 October 2020. Church representatives advised they would be installing a brighter light above the steps and two battery-operated lights in the ground at the top of the steps.

However, since approving the work CPC have since received a request to re-lay the north path due to a concern this area could be a trip hazard.

Please could you give me some advice on whether there is a planning regulation that would apply to this specific issue.
