We operate a preschool model, that is, we follow the model of school hours and terms each academic year.

Education in the UK is delivered as a set of key stages by age, of which we deliver the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) which runs up to the age of five. We are registered with and approved by Ofsted, the government's education inspection agency. What are the aims and objectives of your organisation?

- 3. We participate actively in the life of the village through fundraising activities at community events.
- 4. We provide school hour, term time employment for more than ten people nearly all of whom are Cuckfield residents. Whilst not all our employees have young children, many do, and we enable these people to return to work in a way that balances with having a young family.
