Cllr Oversby-Powell declared an interest in Item 9 as he is resident on the High Street.

RT006 Public Question Time

No members of the public were present.

- **RT007** To approve the minutes of the meeting held on 15th February 2018 The minutes of the meeting held on 15th February 2018 were taken as read, confirmed as a true record and signed by the Chairman.
- **RT008** To note the Action List The items on the action list were reviewed and updates were noted.
- **RT009** To discuss the halting of the re-surfacing road works The Assistant Clerk was requested to minute that all members of the Committee were very unhappy that the roads works had been halted. Cllr Mercer advised works will recommence at the end of June 2018. It is not known whether they will be carried out during the day or night.
- **RT010** To replace two salt bins and install one new bin outside Queens Hall Committee members objected to a salt bin being placed outside Queen's Hall.
- **RT011** To receive an update regarding the London Lane Traffic Calming Scheme Cllr Mercer advised that the Highways manager was waiting for final costs and then the scheme would be available for public review. There could be a delay to work if single suppliers are used on the scheme.
- **RT012** To receive an update regarding Community Speed Watch Programme Cllr Mercer advised interest in the programme is waning. Two members had left and four members had not signed up to GDPR, leaving fourteen members in the group.
- **RT013** To review a summary of data obtained from the Speed Indicator Device (SID) Data reviewed shows it will be difficult to enforce a 20mph speed limit. However, the programme will continue to encourage speeds below 30mph.

The speed limit sign by Fairfax, Broad Street could be moved by up to 25 metres without a TRO.

RT014 To discuss Speed Awareness Wheelie Bin stickers

Committee members dismissed the use of wheelie bin stickers are they were illegal.
