No actions were outstanding for review.

- FGP013 To consider the year to date (5th January 2023) 2023-24 budget:
  - a. Review the latest budget position (to 5<sup>th</sup> January 2024)

    Committee reviewed the budget to date and had no concerns regarding the expenditure for the balance of 2024.
  - b. To consider the Reserves

The Clerk was instructed to start allocating Horsefield Green reserves towards the staff costs incurred to maintain the site. This would be effective from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2024.

- c. To consider the budget forecast for 2024-2025 and resolve to agree the final Precept figure for approval at the Full Council meeting on 18<sup>th</sup> January 2024 Committee resolved to recommend at 6% increase to the precept for 2024-25. This would create a precept pf £276,980, which equated to a Band D cost of £163.28 per year, which would be an increase of £0.18 per week. The budget for Planning would be increased to £10,000 for 2024-25 to cover the increased costs associated with updating the Neighbourhood Plan as well as consultant costs incurred opposing the proposed housing sites at Hatchgate Lane and Cuckstye.
