- **25)** To approve the minutes of the Full Council meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2025

  The minutes of the Full Council meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2025 were approved and signed.
- 26) To discuss and consider the transfer of MSDC assets to CPC in association with the devolution

Council resolved to initiate an open discussion with MSDC to understand which assets could be transferred to the parish council ownership and to clarify the mechanisms required to begin the transfer process.

It was agreed that the Council would express interest in taking on all MSDC managed assets within the parish and would seek advice from Cllr Avery regarding MSDC's position on the matter. The MSDC assets identified for consideration included the Glebe Road allotments, the Play Meadow, Broad Street Car Park, Whitemans Green fields, Cuckfield Recreation Ground (Worsley Memorial Rec) and Church Platt parking.

  - a. To receive an update on the actions taken regarding council assets

    Council noted that progress had been made with the proposed without prejudice resolution. The Parish Council's solicitor had confirmed that a draft conditional contract would be sent to the opposing party's solicitor by the end of the week.

Council noted that the CPC solicitors had issued a letter to the property owners in relation to the ongoing issue concerning the northern boundary of the Observer Field.

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Council noted that no update had been received from the Courtmead Road Residents' Association and instructed the Clerk to follow up on the matter.
