Temporary Traffic Regulation Order for London Lane – One Way System

Monday 15th June - Sunday 20th September 2020

Many have expressed concerns about the considerable increase in traffic coming through Cuckfield while Hanlye Lane is closed for the roundabout works at Penland Farm, and the increased risk to the safety of pedestrians and children during this time.

In order to mitigate this Cuckfield Parish Council, with West Sussex Highways Department, have arranged to implement a temporary one-way system on London Lane:

- From Glebe Road junction to Chatfield Road junction will be one way eastbound
- Two way traffic from London Road (Rose and Crown) to Glebe Road will remain unchanged
- Traffic from Haywards Heath will not be able to access London Lane from Broad Street
- Temporary traffic and diversion signs will be in place
- Parking will be restricted on London Lane from the Rose & Crown to Glebe Road for the duration
 of this temporary diversion. Limited parking may be available in the Rose & Crown car park, until
 such time it re-opens to the public
- A speed indicator device (SID) will be erected to monitor speed and number of vehicles
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
- This change is to improve the safety of all those who use London Lane and the support of residents is much appreciated
