

Lay-by Works

West Sussex County Council needs to carry out road works close to your property soon and we are contacting you today to let you know what we are doing.

What we're doing

This project will involve:

Enhancement and improvement works will soon start along London Lane, Cuckfield.

The scheme will involve reconstruction of the following lay-bys:

- Layby 1 London Lane Opp. Glebe Road junction and adjacent to Holly Tree House.
- Layby 2 London Lane Opposite properties from '1 Nelson Villas' to 'Homelea' and at the rear of No's 9 to 24 Hatchlands.

When this will take place

The work will start on **16th March 2020** and is expected to take **7 days** to complete. Our hours of work will generally be between 07.30am and 17.00pm.

Before the works start, we will erect advance warning signs in the local area, letting you know any changes to the start date and marking the extent of the works.

Road Restrictions during the work

In order to protect our workforce and the public:

- Temporary traffic management in the form of three-way lights will be in operation
- Residents will be unable to park in the lay-bys and vicinity of the works whilst operations are being carried out.
